

GRUPO ENERGÍA BOGOTÁ REPORTED \$ 1,05 BILLION REVENUES AND A 52% NET INCOME GROWTH IN THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2019

- *It's noteworthy the behavior of the power transmission business, and its natural gas transportation and distribution companies, TGI and Cálidda, which income grew 40,7% and 70,0%, respectively.*

Bogota, May 16, 2019: Today, Grupo Energía Bogotá posted positive financial results for the first quarter of the year and the most outstanding events of its subsidiaries during this period, which highlighted the favorable performance of its businesses in electric power transmission and natural gas transportation and distribution in Colombia, Peru and Guatemala.

The group's operating revenues increased to \$1,05 billion from \$881.701 million, a 19,3% growth compared to the same period last year, while net income increased by 52,2%, going to \$520.889 million from \$342.336 million.

Revenues from the power transmission business in Colombia increased 31,9% thanks to the Refuerzo Suroccidental Heliconia, Pereira, Cali, and Yumbo projects, among others.

In Transportadora de Gas Internacional (TGI), the 7,3% revenue increase is the result of contracts associated with the Cusiana-Vasconia Phase 3 project, among other projects. The company reported a 40,7% net income increase.

In Cálidda, a natural gas distribution company in Peru, higher revenues were reported due to the expansion of the network, increase in the distribution of natural gas according to the contracted capacity and increased consumption in transport.

Cálidda registered a 9% revenue increase while its income grew by 70%. During the first quarter of this year, the company exceeded 800.000 customers and built 343 kilometers of networks, bringing its distribution system to 10.035 kilometers. The adjusted consolidated Ebitda increased to \$1,4 billion from \$1,1 billion, a 23,3% growth that reflects the profitability and sustainability of the operating activity.

The president of Grupo Energía Bogotá, Astrid Álvarez, highlighted this performance by saying it is due to the good performance of each business line of the organization, which goes ahead with its Corporate Strategic Plan set in 2016 to position itself as a leading group in the Latin American energy sector.
