Completion of the Program of Alienation of the Equity Interest of Ecopetrol in Empresa de Energía de Bogotá S.A. E.S.P.

Bogotá, D.C., October 20, 2017. Empresa Energía de Bogotá S.A. ESP (EEB) hereby informs that on last October 19, Ecopetrol S.A. announced the completion of the Program of Alienation of the Equity Interest of Ecopetrol in EEB, which was approved by the National Government by means of Decree 2305, dated November 13, 2014 and Decree 2110 of 2016, which extended the program's validity up to December 31, 2017.

Pursuant to the provisions set forth in numeral 2 of Article 3 of Decree 2305 of 2014, the Program consisted of two stages. The first stage comprised the offer of 631,098,000 ordinary shares of EEB, which were equivalent to 6.87% of its share capital.

Finally, the process was completed upon placement of the last order filed during the second stage, which was traded through the spot market trading session managed by the Stock Exchange of Colombia (BVC), in which the total equity interest of EEB owned by Ecopetrol was alienated at market prices.

The result of the placement of shares during the BVC spot market trading session was as follows:
