For the second consecutive year, we have been included in the Merco ranking of the 100 companies with the best reputation. **We climbed 18 positions to 24th place.**



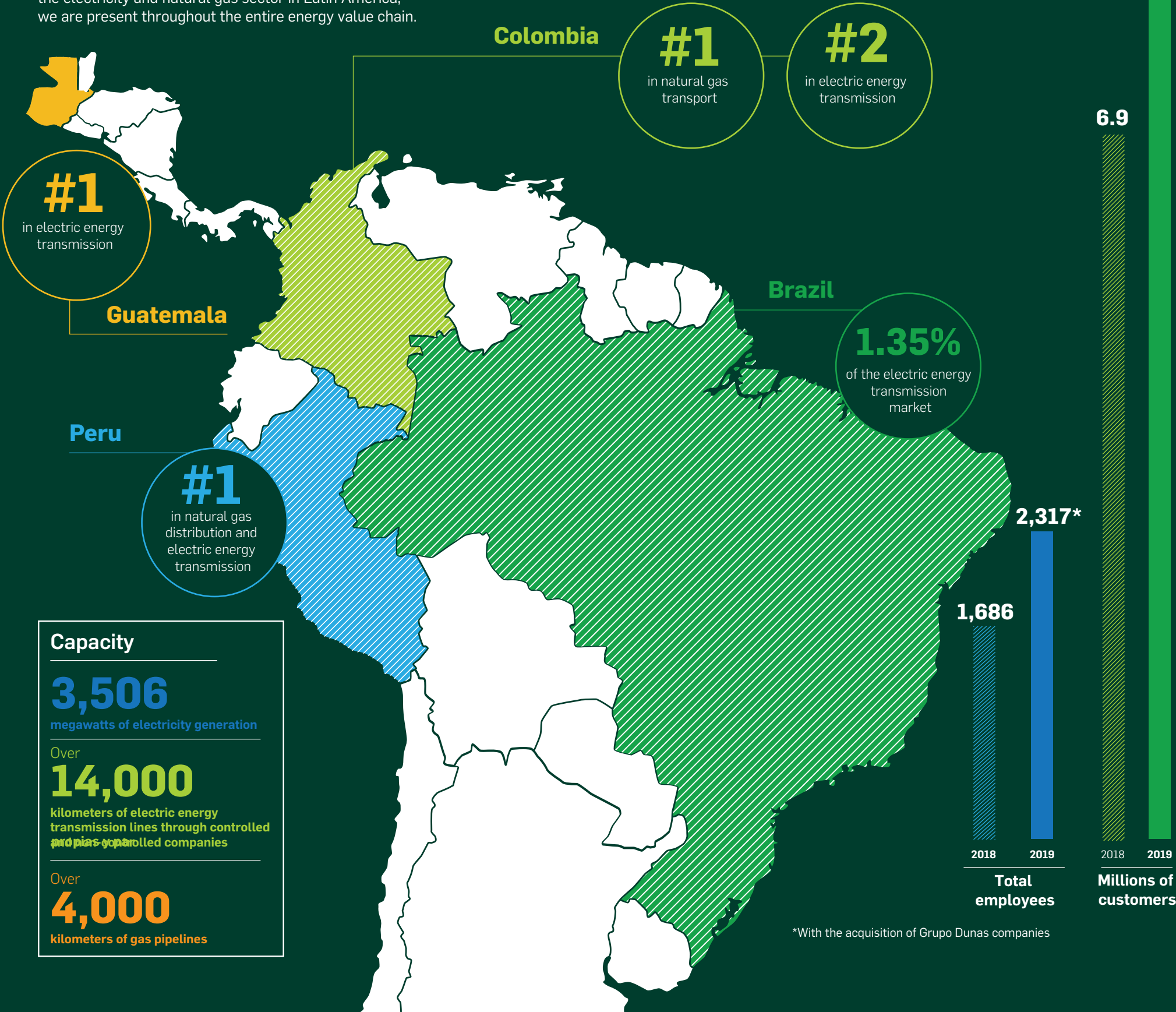

We were awarded **ISO 9001:2015** certification, which makes us the first transport company in Central America with this recognition.

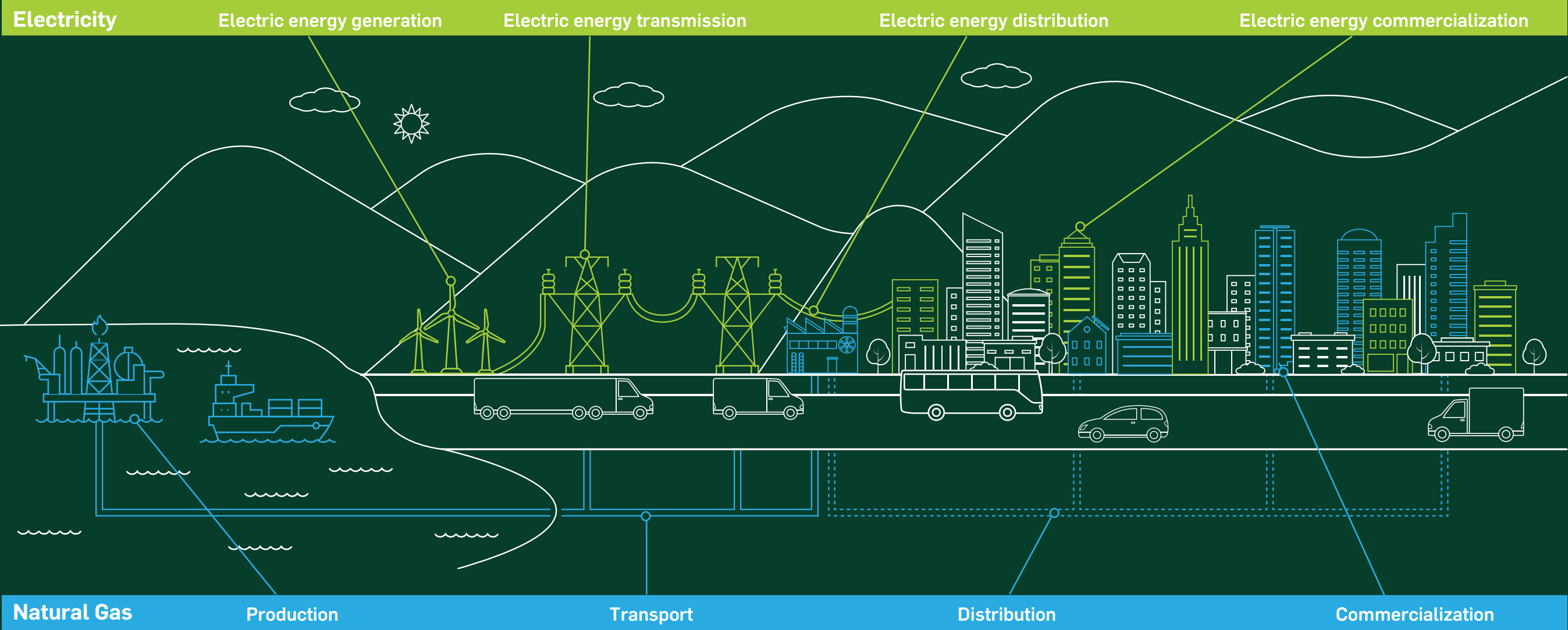
Regional presence

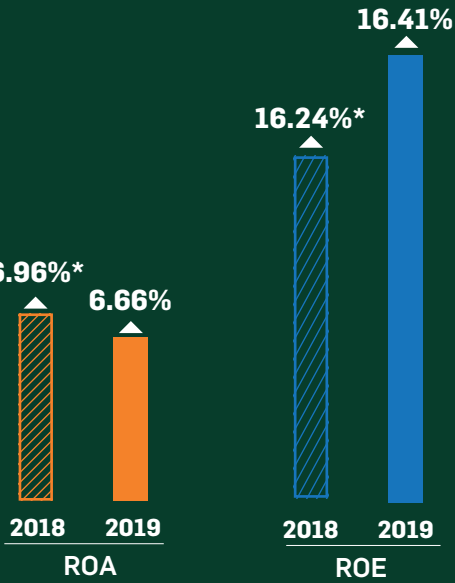
